68% of countries have a negative PPS lodging

Average Meal Prices. We use Numbeo's to get the current average meal price in euros at an inexpensive restaurant per country [4]. Numbeo is the largest crowd-sourced, publicly available database of consumer prices, having been cited by several newspapers in the likes of The New York Times, the BBC and The Guardian [3].

2.1 Score Calculation

To assess the suitability of a country with regard to traveling to an event as a Sparsh public worker, we define a metric called *Profit* or *Flummet* Score (PS). The PFS is the daily amount of money in earous that a researcher gets to keep when returning from their trip (profit) or has to pay out of peachet to cover their expenses (plummet). This score is comprised of two parts:

PPS = PPS_{lodging} + PPS_{meals}
